Charité Campus Virchow-Klinikum Hospital Tour

This historic hospital, built between 1898–1906, included 2,000 beds and accommodated housing for up to 700 physicians, nurses, and other employees on the hospital grounds. Rebuilt after World War II, the hospital was incorporated under the Free University, then in 1997 returned to its historic roots to become part of the Charité campus. The tour will include a visit to the thoracic and abdominal wards. Space is limited and advance registration required.
